The Famous Grouse Lincoln Open 2025

Welcome to the 2025 the Famous Grouse Lincoln Men's Open. Please observe the following instructions for today's play.

- The rules of play shall be those of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and the Local Rules on the scorecard. Please note the instructions regarding placing on fairways.
- Score cards must be properly attested and handed into the Tournament Controllers within 15 min of the completion of the round. Markers scores must appear in the columns provided on the competitor's score card.
- In the event of a tie for the best Senior Gross, the result will be decided by playoff on hole numbers 1 and 9 alternatively. All other ties will be determined by countback.
- Any dispute or protest must be lodged with the Tournament Committee immediately on the completion of the round, and the Tournament Committee's decision on all matters shall be final.

Tee markers (morning 18 holes)

Off No. 1 Tee

1-9 white tees.

10-18 red tees.

19-27 white tees

Start on reverse tees for the afternoon round (9 holes) **play all 9 holes off the white tees**

Nearest the pin on Holes #1/10, and #9/18 for all rounds, check flag for grades.

Use sand buckets provided. Repair pitch marks, replace and/or sand divots. Please ensure you are not guilty of slow play – aim to complete 18 holes in under 4 hours. **Slow play could incur a penalty.**

Free drop – from gardens marked with purple stakes. At rear of 9th hole take drop EITHER side.

Hole 5, Internal out of bounds on the left to the corner & behind #3 green.

Hole 6, Internal out of bounds on the right up to & around the corner.

Have an enjoyable day of golf.

On the day

- Players are to report to the starters **no later than 0745** on the day of play.
- A player briefing will be held at the club house at 0810 all players to attend.
- Players to be at their assigned hole by 0825
- Tee off time is 0830 by a shotgun start. Signalled by sound of a horn.
- Shotgun start after lunch

Hole in One Prize Rules

- The hole in one competition will be on hole 4 (and hole 22) off the white tees only.
- There is only 1 Hole in one prize.
- The first player to achieve a hole in one receives the prize.
- If two players in the same group both achieve a hole in one on the same hole. The prize goes to the player who played first.

Note: Players are responsible for the accuracy of their own card. Inaccurate or non-signed cards will result in disqualification.
