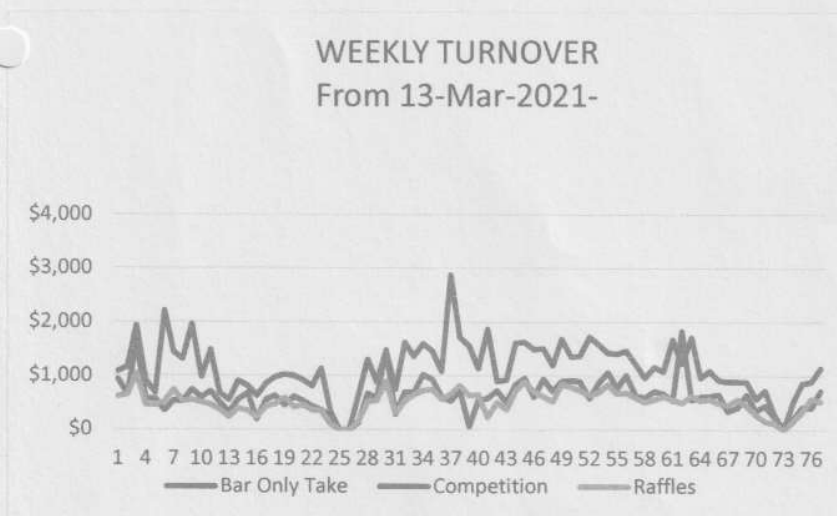

The current graph up to week ending 27 August 2022 follows.


