Report on Canterbury Golf Region Women and Girls Ambition Workshop The discussion/address was held at the Canterbury rooms on 24th February. Emily Davidson addressed us on the the 'need for more work to be done' to make golf more accessible to women and girls. "Golf New Zealand acknowledges there are challenges for women and girls in golf and that gender equity measures, alongside a robust and cohesive plan, are needed to close the gender gap". "Our Ambition to ensure women and girls are Welcomed, valued and thriving in golf" In our afternoon of listening and discussion we learnt that many clubs are doing away with the use of gender words such as 'men's tees' and 'ladies tees'. Instead we should be saying back tees and front tees which are gender neutral. Also we need to pay less attention to set modes of clothing for ladies and concentrate more on are they enjoying the game and will they be happy to bring along friends? We came away with many ideas, prompting us to be inclusive in our language and encouraging on our actions.

BAR REPORT - John Renall

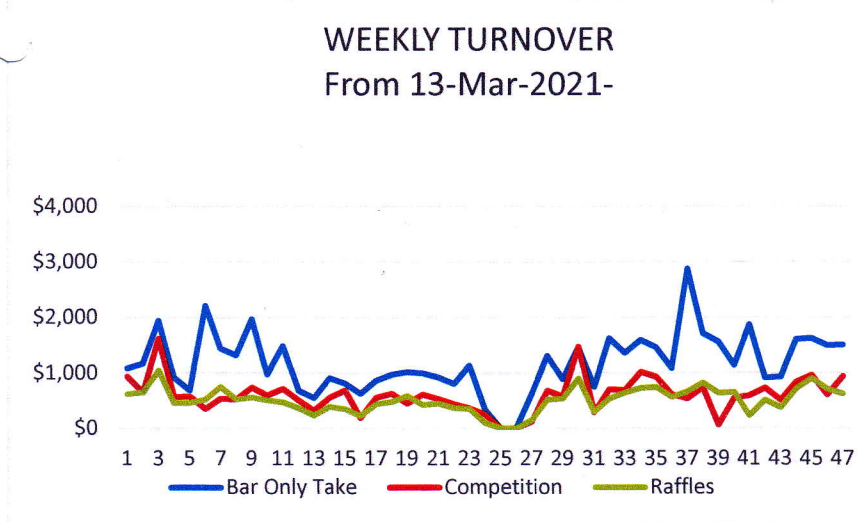
BAR OPERATION
