- The tree stumps on No. 7 have been removed and Ken is in the process of reinstating the ground and re-sowing the grass. The re-sown areas will be marked as GUR.
- We have four new trees to plant courtesy of Mike Youds. The intention is to plant 2 in the rough to the left of No. 7 fairway, and 2 in the gap to the right of No. 8 fairway.
- I have obtained a quote from The NZ Turf Institute for a Field Scout TDR350 Soil Moisture Meter.
